Three skills areas to strengthen:

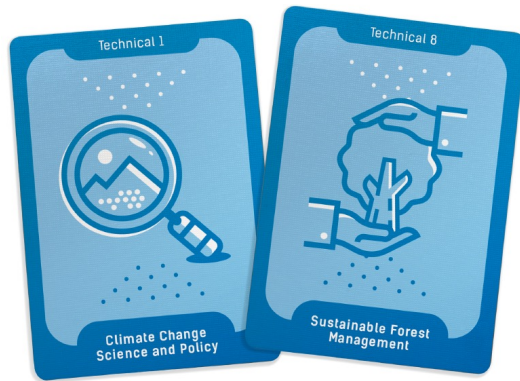
- Technical skills

Network of national and regional training institutions

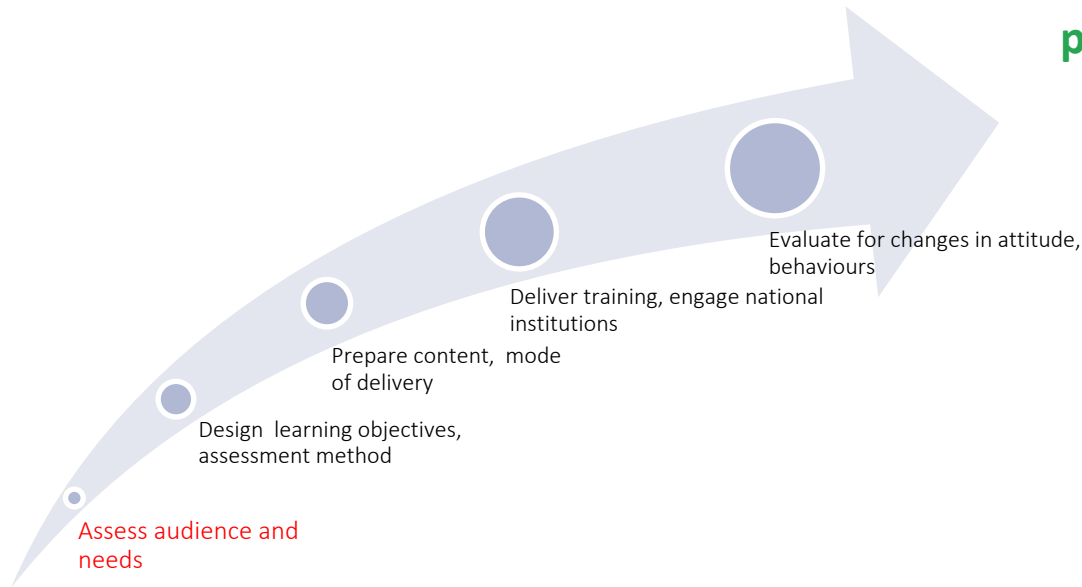


Distance learning platforms accessible to all
