

### **Strategies**:

- TA Support consultants available
- Encouragement to NDAs to utilize national/regional Delivery Partners; greater likelihood of understanding local context and formulating transformational adaptation planning processes.
- Multiple sequential proposals flexibility to address urgent matters, better manage capacity for implementation, apply lessons learnt from previous iterations
- Improved turnaround time for 1st submissions (within 40 working days)
- Regular follow-up once review sheets are shared; open lines of communication
- Technical clearance meetings scheduled weekly


