## **Stakeholder** (n): Individuals or groups who will benefit from or be affected by a project




## **NAP-GSP** Stakeholder identification table

Stakeholder	Reason for interest	Nature of interest (+/-)	Importance (1 to 5, 5 = highest)	Influence (1 to 5, 5 = highest)
Private Iandowners	Need to obtain financial return	-	4	4

Nature of interest:	Supportive or against the project?
Importance:	Important to success of the project
Influence:	What control do they have over the project design or implementation?



## Stakeholder influence-importance map






Stakeholder influence diagram
