- Lack of appreciation of local assets
- Lack of coordination & Working in silos
- Unlimited and uncoordinated reporting exercise;
 - Global- HFA, UNFCCC, SIDS, MDG, UNHCR
 - Regional RFA, PIFACC, PIFS
 - National NC, NPR, Country reports

What works

- Clear goals and objectives that are inclusive
- Whole of society approach
- Appreciation of local assets
- Clear understanding the value of participation
- Strengthening local governance capacity
- Baselines & clear common indicators
- Coordination & synergies & joint-planning
- Simplify reporting
- Documentation of learning from action
